Dear distinguished gathering,

You who have gathered from across the world to help IIMSAM realise its vision of a better tomorrow for the humankind- a future free of malnutrition for the peoples of the world; my words fail to express my gratitude because of their limited power of expression.

It overwhelms me when I see a sea of gathering that has travelled across continents to express solidarity with the cause of IIMSAM. It has been a few years since IIMSAM has been trying to mainstream the use of Spirulina to eradicate malnutrition, achieve food security and bridge the health divide.

This gathering is not only an august platform to renew our commitments to eradicate malnutrition through Spirulina but is also homage to people and children whose innocent lives could have been saved but we failed to do so. The international community is answerable to the ones who lost their lives to the scourge of malnutrition. **The Right to Food and quality nutrition is the most basic of human rights.** It is not only the bedrock but also a prerequisite to other human rights that help a human being live a life of dignity. I remember lines from President Obama in Oslo who while receiving the Nobel Prize for Peace last year said that *if human rights are not protected, peace is a hollow promise.*

How can we be answerable to our own conscience when over a billion people are hungry in this world and millions are on the verge of death because of malnutrition? Just because malnutrition brings silent death to innocent children and emaciated women and men; does that mean the international community has no duty towards saving their lives? It is our collective responsibility and guilt that we failed to save the lives we could have.

It is a pardonable when a person does not know about a solution and therefore is unable to take necessary actions to rectify the situation. But it is criminal to turn a blind eye and avoid taking necessary actions to address the issue when one could. The damage done in the latter case is catastrophic.

The delay in incorporation of Spirulina by the international community as a food fortifying tool to save innocent lives lost to malnutrition and secure the UN MDGs also categorises in that.

Are we not answerable to those whose cries of agony we cannot hear and the tears of anguish we cannot see? Are the developing countries in Asia, Africa, and Latin America in too distant a land in the 21st century globalised world we live in? Or have we become too selfish to pursue our myopic ambitions.

I have always been a man of few words but it brings me a great delight when I see people from across the world espousing the cause of IIMSAM. It also brings hope and strength to commit ourselves towards the cause we have committed ourselves to with a renewed vigour.

I am grateful to my colleague Sheikh Hazim Al Juboori who was instrumental to organise this summit and to Her Royal Highness Princess ***Basma Bint Talal*** who was kind enough to patronise the event. I am confident that with the support of a benevolent person of her eminence and learning would surely help IIMSAM realise its ambition of a world free of malnutrition.
