In a ceremony held at the prestigious India International Centre, New Delhi that celebrated the World Human Rights Day, CISRI-ISP's firm commitment and will to secure the Right to Food and nutrition was reiterated along with the members of the diplomatic community, bureaucracy, UN agencies, media, academia, and the Human Rights fraternity.

CISRI-ISP's Resident Representative and Special Envoy to the region, Mr. Manish Uprety, accepted the award on behalf of the organization by H.E. Mr. Francisco da Câmara Gomes, Head of the European Commission to India and used the platform to announce the official working partnership of the Indian Institute of Human Rights with CISRI-ISP. Mr. Uprety also presented the credentials from CISRI-ISP to Mr. Rahul Rai, Director of Indian Institute of Human Rights and congratulated him for his noble endeavor to help reach the Human Rights education to all that in many countries is somewhat restricted to the diplomatic and legal fraternities.

In his speech, Mr. Uprety expressed thanks on behalf of H.E. Dr. Alessandro Manini, Secretary-General, H.E. Remigio Maradona, H.E. Shariar Rahimi; and H.E. Cavaliere Philip Bonn; and reiterated CISRI-ISP's firm commitment to the FAO's Rome Declaration in a year that marks its tenth anniversary. He also emphasized on the potential of Spirulina in the sustainable development process and the local capacity building besides complementing the aim that is written into the UN WHO constitution on World Food Security that proclaims the enjoyment of the highest attainable standard of health as one of the fundamental rights of every human being without the distinction of race, religion, political belief, economic or social condition.

Firmly committed to the dictum that only when basic necessities are fulfilled will there be real progress, CISRI-ISP would be initiating its pilot projects in the South Asian region in the forthcoming year.

CISRI-ISP has been established through two Multi-Lateral International Agreements [comprising various Member States of the United Nations] that are recognized and registered with the UN Office of Legal Affairs/Treaty Section. UN Treaty Series [37542/43].

CISRI-ISP is accredited as an Observer with the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC), in keeping with resolution E/2003/212, dated 5th March 2003.

Its principal goal is to provide relief to emergency victims of calamities, through the use of food micro-algae Spirulina as an alternative low cost protein source to rehabilitate severely malnourished victims.
