[UN Headquarters, New York 18th September, 2006] CISRI-ISP Permanent Observer Mission to the United Nations/ECOSOC of the *Intergovernmental Institution for the Use of Micro-alga Spirulina against Malnutrition* announced United Kingdom's H.E. Cavaliere Philip Bonn as its Ambassador at-large and Special Envoy to Europe for malnutrition and the United Nations Millennium Development Goals on 18th September, 2006.

A nobleman with a world view, H.E. Ambassador Cavaliere Bonn has been actively involved in humanitarian and philanthropic endeavors, both in the United Kingdom and across the globe. He comes to CISRI-ISP to be a part of the Observer Mission's efforts to advance the fight against severe malnutrition at a global level as well as supporting the universal advancement and achievement of the United Nations Millennium Development Goals.

As an Ambassador at-large and the Special Envoy of CISRI-ISP, Cavaliere Bonn's efforts will be geared towards raising awareness, building partnerships with various stakeholders, and implementing **The Right to Food (UN Resolution 60/165)** across the globe with

particular focus on highlighting severe malnutrition that manifests both as emaciation and obesity. It is perhaps the most pervasive form of Human Rights violation that affects as many as 852 Million people worldwide and causes around 40,000 deaths daily across the globe. H.E. Cav. Philip Bonn will visit global initiatives that are supported by CISRI-ISP to increase visibility of the efforts that are underway to end severe malnutrition.

Ambassador Bonn will also be involved to spread CISRI-ISP's affirmative actions plans viz. the Global Sports for Peace and Culture of Peace and Development that will support and raise awareness worldwide. Ambassador Bonn will be visiting our headquarters in Italy where he will meet our Secretary-General H.E. Dr. Alessandro Manini. Ambassador Bonn will also visit the United Nations Headquarters in October where he will be presented officially to the diplomatic community. He will be inducted officially as our Goodwill Ambassador by the Secretary General Dr. Alessandro Manini and the Head Ambassador of the CISRI-ISP Permanent Observer Mission to UN/ECOSOC H.E. Remigio Maradona.

#### **H.E Ambassador Cav. Philip Bonn: an introduction:**

**H.E. Ambassador Cavaliere Philip Bonn**, MA, FRSA, FRAS, FRAI, FSA Scot, Medal of the Lebanese Red Cross, a Freeman of the City of London, Ambassador at-large, and Special Envoy to Europe for Malnutrition and the United Nations' Millennium Development Goals, (MDG's), comes to CISRI-ISP as the former UK National Chairman (and also as a former Councillor), of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother's BRCS Memorial Fund, of which HRH The Prince of Wales, KG, KT, OM, GCB, PC, is the Royal Patron.

Charitable and humanitarian works form an abiding and significant legacy from both sides of H.E. Cav. Bonn's family. Firstly, the Royal National Institute for Deaf People, (RNID), (of which HRH The Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh, KG, KT, GBE, PC, has been the Royal Patron - since 1958), was founded, and presided over, (1911), by H.E. Cav. Bonn's great grandfather, Mag. Leo Bernard William Bonn, of Newbold Revel, (1850-1929), the uncle of another Bonn philanthropist-knight, invested KBE - Knight of The British Empire, (1926). Secondly, the University of Bristol, was set up through the generosity of Henry Overton Wills I, JP, (1761-1826); H.E. Cav. Bonn's great great great grandfather, and one of the two founding brothers of WD & HO Wills Ltd, of Bristol, (established 1786), later Imperial Tobacco. Thirdly, the British Red Cross was co-founded by Colonel the Right Honourable Sir William Coultts Keppel, (7th) Earl of Albemarle, KCMG, PC, MP, ADC and Treasurer of Her Majesty Queen Victoria's Household, (together with His Lordship's first cousin, Brigadier the Lord Wantage of Lockinge, VC, KCB, MP), the former being the great-great grandfather of H.E. Cav. Bonn.

Philip Edward Leo Africa Bonn was born in London, (1964), 10th in line-of-descent of His Majesty King Charles II of Great Britain. He is the only son and heir, of Major Christopher Leslie Leo Bonn, late the Welsh Guards, (a second cousin of HRH The Duchess of Cornwall), and Edwina Sylvia de Winton Wills, formerly, the Viscountess Savernake and later, the Countess of Cardigan; the younger daughter of Lieutenant Colonel Sir Ernest Edward de Winton Wills, 4th Baronet of Hazelwood, formerly of Meggernie Castle, late the Scots Guards, the first cousin, (by marriage), of the Honourable Mrs Jean Constance Wills, CVO, (born Elphinstone), niece of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother.

H.E. Cav. Bonn was educated at Eton College and is an honours graduate of the University of Cambridge, [BA, (Honours) and MA], where he served as the Duke of Norfolk Memorial Librarian and as an Assistant to the Director of the von Hugel Institute; for two notable conferences on Poverty and Roman Catholic Social Thought, at Fitzwilliam College, Cambridge, and at Archbishop's House, Westminster, respectively. The latter conference was the occasion of the last address, ever given, by His Eminence George Basil, Cardinal Hume, CH, the late (RC) Archbishop of Westminster.

A registered volunteer of the British Red Cross, (2002), H.E. Cav. Bonn served, (2001-02), as a member of the BRCS Gala Committee for Her Majesty The Queen's Golden Jubilee, in respect of a programme of events at the Foreign and Commonwealth Office, London, for which Her Majesty Queen Rania Al-Abdullah of Jordan was the Royal Patron. H.E. Cav. Bonn was later instrumental in raising significant funds for the relief and rehabilitation of the Tsunami victims, through gaining celebrity support for the appeal, in London. He had earlier visited India to meet with the Honourable Ministers of Tourism, Youth and Sport, and the British Ambassador in Delhi.

In recognition of his international humanitarian works, H.E. Cav. Bonn was knighted, (2004), as a "Cavaliere dell'Ordine dei Santi Maurizio e Lazzaro", in Le Palais de Savoie, Aix-Le-Bain, France; by HRH Prince Emanuele Filiberto, Prince of Venice and Prince of Piedmont; with the following citation, "Preso atto dell'impegno assunto di perseguire le finalita Umanitarie e filantropiche proprie dell'Ordine, ed in considerazione della sua figura morale." [Royal Decree 1306 of 4th November 2002].

In 2005, H.E. Cav. Bonn received the Medal of The Lebanese Red Cross, from the President, General Salim Layoun, in Beirut. Having created several permanent positions for The International Messaging and Tracing Service, which reunites families, H.E. Cav. Bonn has been nominated for numerous honours, in the many countries that benefit from this important service.

H.E. Ambassador Cavaliere Philip Bonn is currently an Advisor to the University of Buckingham, and to the Huangshan University Programme of the Humanitad Foundation.
