**Argentina's Greatest Football Club Boca Junior FC's
President Mr. Mauricio Macri becomes CISRI-ISP's
Goodwill Ambassador for Peace and Development
through Sports**



[UN Headquarters, New York. 7th August, 2006] Argentina's greatest Football Club Boca Junior's FC President Mauricio Macri became the latest Goodwill Ambassador for the Permanent Observer Mission to the UN/ECOSOC of the ***Intergovernmental Institution for the Use of Micro-alga Spirulina against Malnutrition (CISRI-ISP), with its Headquarters in Rome, Italy.*** Ambassador Macri has been actively involved in philanthropic endeavors, in Argentina. On August 7th 2006, H.E. Mauricio Macri has also taken on the role of a Goodwill Ambassador with the Observer Mission to the United Nations/ECOSOC that is dedicated to advancing the fight against severe malnutrition as well as supporting the advancement of the United Nations Millennium Development Goals. As a Goodwill Ambassador, his efforts will be geared towards raising awareness and implementing ***The Right to Food (UN Resolution 60/165)*** across the globe with particular focus on highlighting severe malnutrition that causes 40,000 deaths daily around the world. Goodwill Ambassador Macri will also be organizing sports events through the **CISRI-ISP Global Sports For Peace Programme** that will support and raise the awareness worldwide of this human killer. H.E. Mauricio Macri will be visiting our Office and United Nations Headquarters that are in the offing to initiate a special event where he will be inducted officially as our Goodwill Ambassador.

Mr. Remigio Maradona, Head-Ambassador of CISRI-ISP Observer Mission said, “It is a great pleasure to have Mauricio who has proven his mettle as a champion with Boca on to contribute towards making world a better place for those who face severe deprivations across the world especially in the impoverished nations.”

Goodwill Ambassador H.E. MAURICIO MACRI` s brief introduction:

H.E. Mauricio Macri (born 1959-02-08) is a Deputy representing the city of Buenos Aires, Argentina in the Lower House of the Argentine Congress. He is married and has three children. Macri was born in Tandil, in the province of Buenos Aires, and studied at the Universidad Católica Argentina (UCA), where he received a Bachelor in Civil Engineering. He also attended Columbia Business School, Wharton Business School and Universidad del CEMA. His professional career in business includes management positions in various companies. He gained recognition as president of the one of the most popular football clubs of Argentina, Boca Juniors. He was elected in 1995 and reelected in 1999 and 2003, to complete one of the most successful periods of the club, winning several international competitions. In 2003 Macri made his political debut when he was a candidate for Head of Government of the Autonomous City of Buenos Aires with his party *Compromiso para el Cambio (Commitment to Change)*. He won the first round but lost the runoff election with 47% of the popular vote. In the 2005 legislative elections he won a seat in the Argentine Chamber of Deputies, representing the city of Buenos Aires, with more than 33% of the votes. He joined fellow politician and economist Ricardo López Murphy of Recrear to create a center-right electoral front called Propuesta Republicana (known as PRO) and sits in the PRO block of the Argentine Chamber of Deputies. He is also in discussions with Jorge Sobisch, centre-right governor of Neuquén Province, ahead of the 2007 elections.

CISRI-ISP- a synopsis

CISRI-ISP has been established through two Multi-lateral International Agreements [comprising various Member States of the United Nations] that are recognized and registered with the UN Office of Legal Affairs/Treaty Section. UN Treaty Series [37542/43].

CISRI-ISP is accredited as an Observer with the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC), in keeping with resolution E/2003/212, dated 5th March 2003.

Its principal goal is to provide relief to emergency victims of calamities, through the use of food micro-alga as alternative low cost protein source to rehabilitate severely malnourished victims.
